

PARK POLICIES & ORDINANCES

PARK HOURS Entrances to the Park are open daily from 5AM - Midnight.
EMERGENCIES (Police, Fire or Medical) Use the Police Call Boxes located throughout the Park, go to any attraction and request the Park Police, or call 770-413-5333 from any telephone.
SPEED LIMIT Obey all posted speed limits. 25 MPH on Park roads, and 15 MPH in the Campground, parking lots and near playgrounds. Violators can receive a court citation.
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES Consumption or possession of alcoholic beverages is prohibited on streets, parking lots, the Memorial Lawn or any posted area.
PETS No pets other than dogs and cats are allowed. All dogs and cats must be kept on a leash no longer than 6 feet. Pets are NOT allowed on the attractions, in any ticketed areas, Memorial Lawn, Songbird Habitat and Trails, Walk-Up Trail, at special events or in posted areas. Pet owners are responsible for the removal of pet waste.
VEHICLE SECURITY Please LOCK YOUR VEHICLE and DO NOT leave valuables inside.

RECREATION INFORMATION

PUBLIC PICNIC AREA Public use tables are available on a first-come, first-served basis in our two designated picnic areas noted on the attractions map with . Public use grills are also available to be shared by several groups. Private grills can be used in the public picnic areas only and may not be placed on picnic tables. Private outside catering is never allowed in Stone Mountain Park. No more than six picnic tables and the immediate area around those tables can be used by a single group. Sound systems of any kind cannot carry sound more than 50 feet from the system per Stone Mountain Park Noise Ordinance 5 - 109.
WALK-UP TRAIL When climbing the mountain, please stay on the trail marked with a yellow line. If you walk up the mountain and ride down the Skyride (fee required), there is no transportation back to Walk-Up Trail parking lot. This trail is extremely strenuous.
FISHING Georgia Fishing License mandatory (I.D. required). Refer additional questions about fishing to Stone Mountain Park Campground General Store or visit gofishgeorgia.com.
BOATING Boats are allowed during daylight hours only. Boats with motors over 10 HP are not allowed. Boats must have all required safety equipment per state law, including a PFD for every occupant of a boat. Violators can receive a court citation.
BICYCLES Permitted during daylight hours and after dark with proper lights. Bikes must be kept on paved roads and ridden single file on weekends. Georgia Law requires helmets for all riders under age 16.

ADDITIONAL GUEST INFORMATION

To ensure you enjoy your experience at Stone Mountain Park, please be aware of the natural terrain. There are some areas which are potentially hazardous. Use caution when approaching such areas as uneven land.
DESIGNATED SMOKING AREAS In consideration of other guests, please utilize the Designated Smoking Areas at or near each major attraction. These areas are identified with signage and noted on our attractions map with . Smoking and e-cigarettes are prohibited inside all buildings, in queue lines, on the attractions and on the Memorial Lawn. We appreciate your cooperation.
LOST & FOUND All Lost & Found items are turned in each night to the Operations Department. They can be reached at 770-498-5696.
CREDIT CARDS Stone Mountain Park proudly accepts Visa, MasterCard and Discover for admission and at most gift shops and restaurants.
STROLLER/WHEELCHAIR RENTAL When visiting the Park attractions, strollers and/or wheelchairs are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Rental facility located just inside the Main Ticket Plaza at the Adventure Center.
ATM Automatic Teller Machines are located at Skyride Plaza, Marketplace and the Campground.

DESCRIPTIONS & LEGEND FOR THE MAP

PARK ATTRACTIONS: Due to the Park's size, there is a separate map and schedule of all the Park's paid attractions. This map is available at the Crossroads Area/Ticket Plaza (G-8), Memorial Hall (G-7) and at Summit Skyride/Ticket Plaza (G-7). Attractions operate on a seasonal schedule and operating hours vary.

KEY DESCRIPTIONS

- SUMMIT SKYRIDE/TICKET PLAZA*** G-7
This high-speed Swiss cable car provides a stunning view of the world's largest relief carving as it transports you more than 825 feet above the ground to the top of Stone Mountain. You can also purchase your Attractions Ticket for the Park's paid attractions at this location.
- MEMORIAL HALL*** G-7
See and hear the story behind the world's largest relief carving.
- CARVING** F-8
The Stone Mountain Confederate Memorial Carving was completed on March 3, 1972.
- CROSSROADS AREA/TICKET PLAZA** G-8
You can purchase your Attractions Ticket for the Park's paid attractions here.
- TRAIN STATION*** F-8
Here you can climb aboard our train with a full-size locomotive from the 1940s. Enjoy a lively five-mile excursion around the mountain in open-air cars while you marvel at beautiful views of Stone Mountain and the surrounding landscape.
- HISTORIC SQUARE*** H-8
Experience an authentic look at daily life in this collection of historic homes & buildings.
- THE INN AT STONE MOUNTAIN PARK** H-7
This 19th Century inn includes spacious guest rooms, large verandas, and a courtyard pool. Walk to park attractions. For information, call 770-469-3311.
- TOP OF THE MOUNTAIN** E-8
Quench your thirst with a variety of Coca-Cola products or an Isee, plus popcorn and pretzels.
- CARILLON** G-5
Enjoy daily concerts from our 732-bell Carillon, originally exhibited at the 1964 World's Fair.
- WATERFRONT** F-5
To reserve this facility or plan a catered event, please call 770-498-5636.
- GRIST MILL** E-5
The area near the 100-year-old mill and Washington W. King Bridge is a great place for picnics.
- QUARRY EXHIBIT** D-5
This outdoor display brings to life the history of the granite industry at Stone Mountain.

- WASHINGTON W. KING BRIDGE** D-5
Listed in the "World Guide to Covered Bridges," this quaint and historical pine and cedar bridge leads to a picture perfect place for a lazy day of picnics or reading. This century old bridge is nearly 20-feet high and was moved to Stone Mountain Park from Athens, Georgia, in 1969.
- SONGBIRD HABITAT AND TRAIL** A-9
Site of the 1996 Centennial Olympic Archery and Cycling venue, this area is now a songbird habitat, one mile meadow trail and one mile woods trail with a wide array of plant life and food for a variety of birds.
- PLAYGROUND** C-10
The top-notch playground located near the Nature Trail is sure to provide hours of fun for the kids.
- WALK-UP TRAILHEAD** G-13
Set out on the 1 mile trail to the top of the mountain. This trail is extremely strenuous.
- HISTORICAL & ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION CENTER** G-13
Visit the interactive exhibit gallery about the geology and ecology of the mountain, view the "Battle for Georgia" film.
- POLICE/FIRE** I-9
Stone Mountain Park Police and Fire Departments.
- THE COMMONS RESTAURANT** G-4
Located at Stone Mountain Golf Club, The Commons offers indoor & outdoor seating as well as take-away service. Stop in for a drink or a bite to eat. Call 770-465-3306 for more information.
- STONE MOUNTAIN GOLF CLUB** G-4
The Stone Mountain Golf Club offers 36 championship holes, practice facilities, club fitting, PGA instruction and an award-winning pro shop. For tee times, call 770-465-3278.
- STONE MOUNTAIN CAMPGROUND** C-2
Features over 400 sites. Tent and Pop Up sites, RV sites, Yurts, Safari Tents, and Rental Trailers are available. Additional amenities for registered campground guests include a General Store, Seasonal Swimming Pool (no lifeguard present), Volleyball Court, Playground and Laundry Facilities. - PUBLIC BOAT LAUNCH** A-3
Boating is permitted during DAYLIGHT hours only. Boats must be launched from the Public Boat Ramp located near the Evergreen Pavilion. Outboard motors in excess of 10 HP are not allowed on the lake. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed on any privately-owned boat.
- WATERSIDE RESTAURANT** C-4
